Dear Ms. Lewis:

This letter is an addition to the Defect and Non-Compliance report filed by Thor Motor Coach on June 25, 2013 and the update filed on July 8, 2013. NHTSA assigned number 13V-265 to this recall. Thor Motor Coach is reducing the recall population of the affected vehicles by 942 vehicles. Upon review of engineering documents, it was discovered the above vehicles did not contain the defective part as previously thought. The revised population is as follows:

- A. Recall Population and Vehicle Identification. The motorhomes built with the safety defect are as follows:

These motorhomes were built between April 29, 2005 and March 28, 2013. The total number of motorhomes subject to this recall campaign is 7593.
