This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

#### REASON FOR THIS RECALL

Matthews Specialty Vehicles has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain vehicles equipped with Dometic Awnings. Due to a potential condition with the motor in the Weatherpro Awning, the awning can unfurl unexpectedly, either while the coach is at rest or while in transit.

#### WHAT WE WILL DO

We will provide the information, locate a repair facility and follow up to insure the repairs are completed accordingly.

#### WHAT YOU SHOULD DO

Please contact Matthews Specialty Vehicles as soon as possible to arrange a service date and so the dealer may order the necessary parts for the repair. Instructions for making this correction have been sent to your dealer and the parts are available. The labor time necessary to perform this service correction is an hour.

Matthews Specialty Vehicles is best equipped to obtain parts and provide service to ensure that your vehicle is corrected as promptly as possible. If, however, you take your vehicle to your dealer on the agreed service date, and they do not remedy this condition on that date or within three (3) days, we recommend you contact Matthews Specialty Vehicles customer service by calling 1-336-297-9600 x 213.
