Of the customers notified, 655 (cumulative- 373 this quarter) requested and were provided a new front Floor Liner with a Hook Guard installed. Additionally, Quadrtec® received 55 additional requests (30 this quarter) for Hook Guards only which were supplied to assumed users of the affected floor liners.

(b) Total Number Inspected & NOT REQUIRING REMEDY: Per 577 notification, Quadrtec® recommended all customers inspect or use furnished Hook Guard to reinforce anchor area of suspect Floor Liners. Customers were given option of returning suspected torn liners for exchange. Among the 406 liners returned as of 7/15/13, Quadrtec® has inspected a cumulative total of 66 liners (46 this quarter) which appeared untern.
