Re: Safety Notice Pertaining to All Kuryakyn Handlebar Risers/Setbacks for GL1800 (Kuryakyn part number 7437)

Dear Kuryakyn Purchaser,

This recall notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Kuryakyn Holdings, LLC (“Kuryakyn”) has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists with Kuryakyn Handlebar Risers/Setbacks for GL1800 (Kuryakyn part number 7437). These handlebar risers/setbacks, sold between April 3, 2013 and July 1, 2013, may have screws that fracture suddenly after installation. If the screws fracture, it could potentially cause the OEM handlebar to separate from the steering mount increasing the risk of a crash.

Please immediately discontinue use of your Handlebar Riser/Setback for GL1800. Please contact your local motorcycle dealership as soon as possible to have our recall service kit installed, free of charge. In the event that you install the service kit yourself, you will be responsible for all potential issues that might be related to the installation.

If you know of anyone who bought this product, or may be using them, please let us know their name and address as well so that we can send this notice to them. Federal regulation requires that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days.

If you have had your handlebar risers/setbacks repaired for this issue prior to receipt of this notice, you may be entitled to reimbursement if you incurred any out of pocket cost due to this matter. For further information, please contact us at the number listed above.

We regret any inconvenience that this action may cause you. However, we are concerned about your safety.
