Reduction in Population of Vehicles Potentially Containing Defect**

Dear Kelly,

This letter is to advise RMD of a slight change in the number of vehicles involved in Recall No. 13V-322. The recall affects 802 Kenworth vehicles in the United States, not 813 vehicles as stated in our 573 report dated July 22, 2013. Following the initiation of the recall, Kenworth determined that 11 vehicles included in the original count were equipped with a wiring harness that prevented the defect from occurring in those vehicles.

We would appreciate your assistance in amending NHTSA's records to reflect the decreased vehicle population. This will ensure consistency between the agency's files and the data submitted in Kenworth's forthcoming quarterly report.
