IMPORTANT: Safety Notice

SAFETY – RECALL – 13V-495

Dear Valued Customer,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Spartan Motors Chassis, Inc. has decided a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain altered vehicles and completed as a transit bus.

Please note: The Vehicle Identification Number that may be affected by this recall is located at the top of this letter.

What is the defect?

The park brake cable may be routed in a manner in which it contacts the rear hydraulic brake line. This contact could lead to a hole being worn in the hydraulic brake line which could result in a loss of rear brakes without warning. Loss of rear brakes could lead to increased stopping distance may result in a vehicle crash.

Corrective Action:

Spartan Chassis will supply retaining clips and instructions on proper retention of the park brake cable. This will be done at no charge.

Labor Time:

Rerouting of the harness is expected to take **1 hour**.

Due to some service scheduling times, your service center may need your vehicle for a longer period.

What You Should Do:

Call Spartan Chassis at 800-543-4334 to locate a qualified service center near you. Steps will be taken to ensure the recall is performed at the nearest service center.

Leased Vehicles:

The lesser must notify the lessee by first class mail within ten (10) days from receipt of their owner notification letter from the manufacturer; both for the initial notification and all subsequent notifications.

Reimbursement:

If you had this repair performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall. For more information contact Spartan Chassis at 800-543-4334.

Please fill out the enclosed prepaid postcard and mail it to us if you have changed your address, sold, or traded the vehicle.
