Important Safety Recall

SAFETY RECALL NOTICE – NHTSA CAMPAIGN NUMBER _13V-375_____

Dear Lion Bus Owner :

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

REASON FOR THIS RECALL

Lion Bus Inc. has decided that certain model year 2013 and 2014 Lion school buses model 360 fail to conform to the requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 111 « Rear View Mirrors ». These vehicles have a problem with the right crossview arm that is too short. This do not allow the driver to view totally close to the bumper as well as close to the side wall of the bus, increasing the risk of a crash.

Also there is a decal missing above the driver's view to explain the procedure with these mirrors.

Misuse of the mirror can result in personal injury.

WHAT WE WILL DO

We will supply the replacement arm as well as the wiring harness that can be too short. There will be a written procedure to follow that is really simple; 4 bolts to remove and 4 bolts to get loose on the mirror head, remove the sealant inside the hood that avoid moisture to get in the tube and push the harness to see the connector at the other end. There will be also pictures with this procedure to explain clearly the steps to follow. We estimate 20 to 25 minutes to do the job.

Regarding the decal it is supplied in the same package and should be applied at location explained on the pictures.

If you are no longer owner of this vehicle, please provide us with any contact information so we may contact the new owner.

Federal law requires any lessor who receives a notification of a determination of a safety related defect of noncompliance pertaining to any leased motor vehicle shall send the notice to the lessee within 10 days.
