Winnebago Industries<sup>®</sup> submits the following report pursuant to Part 573 of the NHTSA regulations. The numbered paragraphs below correspond to those found at Part 573.6(c).

1. Winnebago Industries, Inc.

2. The motor vehicles potentially containing the defect are on certain 2014 and 2015 model years Winnebago Travato<sup>™</sup> and Winnebago Trend<sup>™</sup> motorhomes and 2014 and 2015 model years Itasca Viva!<sup>™</sup> motorhomes built on the Ram ProMaster chassis. These motorhomes were built November 13, 2013 through June 9, 2014. The vehicles are being identified using the model number and production records showing VINs.
3. The total number of vehicles potentially containing the defect is 653.
4. The percentage of vehicles estimated to contain the defect is 100 percent.
5. The affected vehicles may experience circuit corrosion from water intrusion around the in-floor battery cover and door footwell trim. The water intrusion may affect the running of the vehicle and disable the airbags, stop lamps, turn signals, backup lights, and/or door locks increasing the risk of a crash, as well as injury to the occupants if the airbags do not deploy.
6. Winnebago Industries discovered the defect as a result of a telephone call with Chrysler Group LLC on June 9, 2014.

8. Chrysler<sup>®</sup> is conducting their recall under NHTSA No. 14V-294. Winnebago Industries has provided Chrysler a current list of owners and will continue to assist them to correct the situation. Chrysler will notify owners and will make repairs free of charge.
