KME Fire Apparatus Vehicles having Meritor Axles Equipped with
Meritor DiscPlus EX225 Air Disc Brakes, and Q Plus Cam Brakes
Manufactured between November 23, 2010 and October 22, 2012, that
Utilize Certain MGM Type 24 J-Series Piston Parking Brake Actuators**

- (1) The notification campaign identification number assigned to this matter by NHTSA is 13V-137.
- (2) The date notification began is April 15, 2013. The first notification to customers has been completed. It is our intention to follow-up with non-responsive customers.
- (3) The number of vehicles or items of equipment involved in the subject notification campaign is 41.
- (4) The number of vehicles and equipment items which have been inspected and repaired as of September 30, 2013, is 32. No determination has been made regarding any of the subject vehicles that may not need the repair. All of the subject vehicles are being repaired regardless of whether they have manifested the defect.
- (5) No vehicles or items of equipment have been determined to be unreachable for inspection due to export, theft, scrapping, failure to receive notification or any other reasons.
- (6) There are no vehicles or items of equipment repaired and/or returned by dealers, other retailers, and/or distributors to the manufacturer prior to their first sale to the public.
- (7) The subject recall does not involve replacement of tires.
