Attached is a letter from Mazda providing notification that Mazda intends to implement a Special Service Program for our customers in certain regions of the United States and its Territories. This is a voluntary action by Mazda to minimize the possibility of additional incidents occurring in the field, as identified in the Opening Resume for PE14-016, and to support the expedited collection of parts for analysis.

We are planning to provide notification to the effected owners, but we do not currently have a schedule for the notification. We are working with Takata to establish the schedule for the availability of the repair parts. We will notify you of the planned schedule, as well as provide a copy of the draft owner notification letter, when they are available.
