



**J&J TRUCK BODIES “IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL” – PTO PRESSURE SWITCH**

**NHTSA SAFETY RECALL NO. 13V-458 and 14E-016**

*Dear J&J Truck Body Owner:*

*This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Highway Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.*

**REASON FOR THIS RECALL:**

*J&J Truck Bodies has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain vehicles equipped with Muncie PTO Assembly Pressure Switches, part number 30T37594. The Recall is specific to the 2009-2014 Ford F350-F550 Super Duty chassis with the 6.8L Gasoline Engine. On this application the pressure switch is installed in close proximity of the engine exhaust pipe. If improperly positioned to close to the exhaust, the switch can see excessive heat, damage the internal diaphragm, possibly leading to a seep of transmission fluid out the switches screw in the side of the body. The combination of a thermal blanket with a deteriorated surface, and the possibility of the seepage of fluids as a possible source of fuel, could result in the heat blanket material absorbing these fluids over time, resulting in a potential fire.*

***Your vehicle, identified by the VIN NUMBER on this letter, is affected.*** For this reason we ask that you arrange for service to correct the condition without delay.

**WHAT WE WILL DO:**

*J&J Truck Bodies will provide for the necessary repairs to your body free of charge. This will include parts and labor within the limitations described below.*

**WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:**

*Choose from the following options:*

- A. *Contact J&J’s warranty administrator, Gary Shaffer at (814) 444-7044 and schedule your unit for repair at J&J Bodies facility in Somerset, Pa.*

*B. Schedule the unit for repair at the nearest approved repair facility (List is enclosed). J&J will supply the repair facility with parts and specific instructions. J&J will pay ½ hour in labor per unit for the repair*

*Once you have decided on an option, contact the warranty administrator with the following information:*

- A. Body serial number (Typically located driver side front corner post)*
- B. Repair facility in which you choose to take your dump body, so that we may send them the parts necessary to complete the repair (Option B Only)*

*The work should take about ½ hour to complete. However, additional time may be required depending on how dealer appointments are scheduled and processed. To obtain this free service:*

- Contact your approved service center as soon as possible to schedule an appointment for the free service*
- Provide the repair center with the enclosed work instructions*
- Provide the repair center with the enclosed Repair Completion Form. The form identifies the vehicle and the service that is required and what the repair provider is required to fill out and return to J&J for payment*



*If you have leased this equipment to another person or company, you are required by Federal Law to forward a copy of this notice to the lessee by first class mail within (10) days of the receipt of this notice.*
