

IMPORTANT SAFETY NOTICE

Dear Valued Graco Consumer:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Graco has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain Graco SnugRide® and Aprica A30 infant child restraints as listed in the table below. Specifically, the buckle (see picture below the table) may become difficult to unlatch or become stuck in the latched position, making it difficult to remove an infant from their car seat and increasing the risk of injury in the event of an emergency requiring immediate exit from the vehicle.

Aprica A30	July 2011 – April 2012



Graco will provide owners with free replacement buckles of a different design which can be easily installed on their infant car seats to replace the existing buckles.

Not all Graco infant car seats made in date ranges above are affected by this action. Owners of Graco infant car seats should visit www.gracobucklerecall.com, call 1-877-766-7470 or email consumerservices@gracobaby.com to determine if their infant car seats are affected and to register to receive a free replacement buckle. You will need the model name, number and date of manufacture for your infant car seat when you contact Graco. This information may be found on a white label on the underside of the carrier portion of your infant car seat. You may continue to use your car seat until your buckle repair kit arrives.
