Re: Recall 14V-262 –Part 573 Report Update

On May 16, 2014, Suzuki Motor of America, Inc. ("SMAI") submitted a Part 573 report concerning a defect in 2004-2008 Suzuki Forenza and 2005-2008 Suzuki Reno passenger cars. On May 30, 2014 and June 24, 2014, SMAI submitted updates to the original Part 573 report.

Due to an uncertain parts supply situation, SMAI sent Suzuki Service Providers and owners of affected vehicles interim notification letters for the recall. Vehicle owners were informed that they would be sent a second notification letter when recall parts are available. SMAI has recently received parts supply and service procedure information which allows us to update the Service Provider and owner notification schedule for this recall. SMAI expects that it will be able to issue a service procedure to Suzuki Service Providers by October 10, 2014, and will be able to begin sending second owner notification letters by October 17, 2014.
