This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Gillig has decided, based on information supplied by Cummins, that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in fuel filters purchased through Gillig's Parts Department.

What The Issue Is:

The fuel filter can come apart causing an engine stall and inability to restart. This condition may lead to an increased risk of a crash.

**What We Are Asking
You To Do:**

- 1. Review the list of Purchase Orders attached, contact your local Cummins Dealer to have the fuel filters replaced on any vehicle they're installed on. If the filters are not installed, return them to Cummins for reimbursement or replacement. This review and notification to Cummins should not take more than fifteen minutes***
- 2. Federal regulations require that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days.***
- 3. If you have already performed this repair, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of performing the repair which is the subject of this recall. For more information contact Gillig Service at 800.735.1500, or your local Cummins Dealer.***

1. **We will assist in getting you in contact with your local Cummins Dealer, if needed. We have also provided a list of PO's these filters were purchased under.**
