This letter is being provided in response to your letter of October 10, 2014. Today and tomorrow Bombardier Recreational Products Inc. ("BRP") is and will be providing a partial response to the Information Request in PE14-025. Specifically, pursuant to discussions with Robert Young of your office, BRP is providing its responses, for December 4th, to Request No. 1, 16, 17, 24, 25, 26, 28, 31, 34, 35 and 36 and partial response for number 9 and 30 of the Information Request as agreed. In addition, requests No. 22, 32 and 33 have been cancelled. BRP expects to provide its responses to the other requests in the Information Request as per our extension request of November 27th.

Today, we are providing responses to Request No. 1 and tomorrow, we will send responses to all the remaining responses agreed.

Because the information submitted today consists of confidential business information, BRP is submitting the information, together with a request for confidential treatment and a certificate in support of confidentiality, to the Office of Chief Counsel.

In compiling the information responsive to Request No. 1, BRP has endeavoured to search the BRP files and records in which such information is most likely to be found. BRP believes that the search it has conducted for responsive information is reasonable, and BRP is providing all responsive materials that have been identified to date. If BRP identifies other responsive materials, it will supplement this submission.

As you requested, we have repeated the request above each response.

Request 1

State, by production year, the number of subject vehicles manufactured by BRP. Separately, for each subject vehicle manufactured to date, state the following:

- a. Vehicle identification number (VIN);
- b. Model Year;
- c. Model (RT, SE5, RS, SM5, etc.);

Sea-Doo
Evinrude
Rotax
Can-Am

- d. Model designation (e.g., C2EB, C2EC, etc.);
- e. Date of Manufacture;
- f. Warranty coverage start date;
- g. Original purchaser first and last name; and
- h. Selling dealer Can-Am number (694784, 690354, etc.)


Provide this information in Microsoft Access 2010, entitled "PRODUCTION DATA." A template to assist with database configuration is being sent separately.
