This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Agility Fuel Systems, Inc. has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in Agility-supplied CNG fuel systems equipped with certain Motion Industries T1700-06 flexible fuel hoses. The CNG fuel system installed on your vehicle (identified above) may be affected. Agility is conducting a safety recall to address this condition.

What is the issue?

The stainless steel braid reinforcement on some of the Motion Industries T1700-06 flexible fuel hoses used in the CNG fuel system may be susceptible to premature corrosion near the fitting crimp inside the slave tank enclosure, possibly due to a combination of the accumulation of road salt and the humid environment within the enclosure. If the corrosion progresses and remains undetected, the hose may leak in sufficient volumes as to create a risk of fire if an ignition source is present. In addition, a high-

pressure fuel leak may create a risk of damage to surrounding components and/or personal injury to adjacent personnel.

The corrosion is progressive and would likely be visible at the crimped end of the hose assembly upon inspection prior to actual leakage. Furthermore, early stages of a leak may be detected by a combustible gas detector, leak testing solution or smell.

What will Agility do?

Agility and its authorized representatives will inspect your vehicle to determine whether it is equipped with one of the defective hose assemblies. If so, Agility will replace the defective hose assembly free of charge (parts and labor). Replacement parts are currently available. Installation of the replacement hose assemblies is expected to take less than one hour. However, because of scheduling needs, the vehicle may need to be available for a longer period. We will do our best to minimize the time that the vehicle needs to be available.

What should you do?

Please call Agility Fuel Systems at your earliest opportunity at (949) 267-7745 to schedule a service appointment. Please mention Recall No. 14E-056 and provide the VIN of the vehicle as shown above in this letter. If you no longer own this vehicle and have an address for the new owner, please forward a copy of this letter to the new owner and provide Agility with updated contact information at (949) 267-7745.

Note: *Federal law prohibits the delivery of affected vehicles or equipment under a sale or lease until the defect has been remedied. Federal law also requires that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice forward a copy of the notice to the lessee with 10 days.*
