This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Agility Fuel Systems (Agility) has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in CNG fuel systems equipped with certain Motion Industries T1700-06 flexible fuel hoses. Agility is conducting a safety recall to address this condition. According to our records, Agility delivered the following potentially defective equipment to you on or about the date(s) shown:

What is the issue?

The stainless steel braid reinforcement on some of the Motion Industries T1700-06 flexible fuel hoses used in the CNG fuel system installed on these vehicles may be susceptible to premature corrosion near the fitting crimp inside the slave tank enclosure, possibly due to a combination of the accumulation of road salt and the humid environment within the enclosure. If the corrosion progresses and remains undetected, the hose may leak in sufficient volumes as to create a risk of fire if an ignition source is present. In addition, a high-pressure fuel leak may create a risk of damage to surrounding components and/or personal injury to adjacent personnel.

The corrosion is progressive and would likely be visible at the crimped end of the hose assembly upon inspection prior to actual leakage. Furthermore, early stages of a leak may be detected by a combustible gas detector, leak testing solution or smell.

What will Agility do?

Agility and its authorized representatives will inspect the vehicle to determine whether it is equipped with one of the defect hose assemblies. If so, Agility will replace the defective hose assemblies free of charge (parts and labor). Replacement parts are currently available. Installation of the replacement hose assemblies is expected to take less than one hour per vehicle. However, because of scheduling needs, the vehicle may need to be available for a longer period. We will do our best to minimize the time that the vehicle needs to be available.

What should you do?

For affected vehicles that remain in your inventory, please call Agility to schedule a repair. For fuel systems installed in vehicles that have left your control, we encourage you to make a safety defect determination in accordance with 49 USC 30118 *et seq.* and, as appropriate, to submit a Defect Notification to NHTSA in accordance with 49 CFR Part 573.

Agility wants to have this recall service completed on all affected vehicles and needs your assistance in locating them. Therefore, please provide a copy of this letter and the attached owner letter to your affected customers and send the name, address and VIN information for the affected vehicle(s) to Agility Fuel Systems at 1815 Carnegie Ave, Santa Ana, CA 92705; Attention: Yoshio Coy. Agility will follow up with owners to arrange the repair. If you were an intermediate-stage manufacturer and do not have VIN or owner contact information, we request that you obtain that information from your customers and forward it to us to follow up.

Federal law prohibits the delivery of affected vehicles or equipment under a sale or lease until the defect has been remedied.
