Re: Toyota Safety Recall 13V-029

Dear Ms. Timian:

This letter confirms our recent conversation with Mr. Borris concerning Recall 13V-029. As discussed, Toyota intends to modify the remedy relating to this recall. All vehicles previously identified will receive new airbag control modules. We intend to re-notify owners of the subject vehicles who have already presented their vehicles for repair and had the noise filter installed but did not receive a new airbag control module, instructing them to return their vehicles for an airbag control module replacement.

We are currently developing a schedule for the re-notification process and will provide this to you at a later date. Drafts of the owner communications for this re-notification will also be provided to you for review and approval.

It is our intention to re-calculate our quarterly completion rate reporting and not count any of the vehicles which did not receive a new airbag control module as having been completed until a new airbag control module has been installed. We are prepared to discuss the details of this with you to assure accuracy of our reporting. We also plan to restart our quarterly reporting cycle from the date of the re-notification through the typical six full quarters.
