**Subject: Failure to File Required Recall Quarterly Report**

Dear Mr. Collins:

On February 6, 2015, we wrote to you for Columbia Northwest, Inc., and informed you that your company had not yet submitted its fifth quarterly report for the third quarter of 2014 on its recall campaign. A copy of our message and its delivery receipt is enclosed with this letter.

We still have not received the requested, and required, report. See 49 U.S.C. 30120 and 49 CFR 573.7 and 573.9.

Columbia Northwest also has not filed its quarterly report for the fourth quarter of 2014 that was due on or before December 31, 2014.

I urge your company to comply with its obligations and file this report through its secure, online recalls account. This documentation is necessary to ensure the proper administration and progress of a safety recall designed to remove products that are defective and/or fail to meet minimum safety standards from U.S. roadways, and a serious responsibility for us both.

Continued failure to produce the required documentation may result in a referral of your client's company to our Office of Chief Counsel for a potential enforcement action, including injunctive relief and/or civil penalties.
