Dear Valued Starcraft Dealer:

Starcraft has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain Model Year 2016 Autumn Ridge and AR-ONE Maxx travel trailers manufactured March 17, 2015 through April 14, 2015. The affected vehicles may have defective studs on the drums supplied by and installed on the Lippert Components Axle assemblies. If the stud fails, the wheel could detach from the vehicle, increasing the risk of a crash.

The remedy is to inspect the LCI axle assembly with the manufacture date to confirm if the existing drum is affected by the recall. Drums confirmed to be affected by this recall will be replaced at no charge to the owner. The recall remedy will take approximately one half hour (.5) per hub. All pertinent documents pertaining to this recall are on file under the Service and Parts tab of Star Connect.

Our records show the following Starcraft units are affected by this recall and are currently part of the inventory at your dealership and require the Recall repair prior to being sold:
