Re: Recalls 15V-284, 15V-285, and 15V-286

Dear Mr. Borris:

This is in response to your request for a brief summary of Toyota's current Takata recalls. As a result of our filings earlier today, Toyota currently has the following recalls relating to Takata air bag inflators:

- 15V-284 covers model year 2004 and 2005 Toyota RAV4 with Takata-designated PSDI-5 driver's inflators. This recall is nationwide.
- 15V-285 covers model years 2003-2007 Corolla and Corolla Matrix, 2003-2006 Tundra, 2002-2007 Sequoia, and 2002-2007 Lexus SC430 vehicles. These vehicles contain Takata-designated SPI, PSPI, or PSPI-L front passenger inflators. The covered vehicles were not sold or ever registered in States or Territories of High Absolute Humidity (HAH).
- 15V-286 covers the same models, model years, and Takata inflator types as in 15V-285, but the covered vehicles were those sold or ever registered in the HAH States and Territories as defined in our amendments filed today. We have separated this population of vehicles so they can be prioritized for parts allocation and tracked separately for quarterly completion reporting to the agency.

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Recalls 15V-285 and 15V-286 supersede 14V-312 and 14V-655, respectively, as the vehicle population from those actions (including the model years 2003-2007 General Motors/Pontiac Vibe) have been transferred to the current 15V recalls as noted in our amended filings today.

In summary, 15V-284, 15V-285, and 15V-286 encompass all of the involved Toyota and Lexus vehicles nationwide. We will report all future completions for these actions under these three recall numbers.
