IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL INFORMATION

August 5, 2015

Dear Ferrari Client,

We wanted to inform you that you will be receiving a letter from Ferrari North America, Inc. shortly concerning a recall on your 2015 Ferrari vehicle.

Ferrari has decided that certain Model Year 2015 Ferrari 458 Italia, 458 Spider, 458 Speciale, 458 Speciale A, California T, FF, F12 Berlinetta and LaFerrari vehicles may have a Driver's Side Air Bag Module that could possibly deploy in a rotated orientation due to a Driver's Side Air Bag Module that was an improperly assembled. We want to assure you that your safety is our priority, and we are committed to correcting this condition in your vehicle.

Your vehicle may have been fitted with a Driver's Side Air Bag Module that was improperly assembled by the Air Bag supplier. This is due to a combination of insufficient gluing of the leather skin of the Driver's Air Bag module cover to the plastic base and improperly rotated orientation of the cushion during the manufacturing process. This safety defect could increase the risk of occupant injuries or death in the event of a front or rear collision.


Ferrari will of course repair your vehicle free of charge. The repair involves replacing the Driver's Side Air Bag Module. When you receive your letter, please contact your local authorized Ferrari dealer and make an appointment to have this repair performed. The time needed for this repair is estimated to be 1 hour; however, your dealer may need to keep your vehicle for a longer period of time due to scheduling needs at the dealership.
