Dear Valued Customer,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Spartan Motors USA, Inc. has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2008 – 2010 model year emergency response chassis cabs equipped with side view mirrors supplied by Retrac.

Please note: The Vehicle Identification Number that may be affected by this recall is located at the top of this letter.

What is the defect?

Mirror lenses may fall out of the mirror housing. If the mirror lens comes loose and falls out, the driver's ability to see objects in the mirror would be impaired, increasing the risk of a crash.

Corrective Action:

New mirrors will be supplied, and installed, at no charge.

Labor Time:

Applying the remedy may take up to 1 hour. Due to some service scheduling times, your service center may need your vehicle for a longer period.

What You Should Do:

Call Spartan at 1-800-543-5008 opt 0 to locate a qualified service center near you. Steps will be taken to ensure the recall is performed at the nearest service center.

Leased Vehicles:

The lessor must notify the lessee by first class mail within ten (10) days from receipt of their owner notification letter from the manufacturer; both for the initial notification and all subsequent notifications.

Reimbursement:

If you had this repair performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall. For more information contact Spartan at 1-800-543-5008 opt 0.

Reply Card:

Please fill out the enclosed prepaid postcard and mail it to us if you have changed your address, sold, or traded the vehicle.

If the authorized service center has failed or is unable to remedy the defect without charge and within a reasonable time, contact Spartan at 1-800-543-5008 opt 0.
