

IMPORTANT SAFETY NOTICE

NHTSA RECALL 15C-001

February 2016


Dear Valued Graco Consumer:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Graco has decided that certain Graco ComfortSport®, Ready Ride® and Classic Ride® child restraints as listed in the table below fail to comply with the requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 213 “Child Restraint Systems”. Specifically, labels (one in English and one in Spanish) on the product are missing the phrase “Follow all instructions on this child restraint and in the written instructions located on the back of the seat”.

This missing information may affect the consumer’s understanding that the written instructions have a storage location and that important use instructions are on the product and in the printed instructions. If the label does not inform the seat owner of the instruction manual’s location, the owner may not be able to refer to it and may use the seat improperly, increasing the risk of injury to the child in the event of a crash.

Graco is providing owners with free replacement labels that can be applied to the child restraint. These labels and application instructions are enclosed with this letter. Your child restraint may already contain the new labels. Please compare the part number of the enclosed labels with the part number on the labels on your product. If they are the same, you do not need to apply the enclosed labels. If your child restraint needs these new labels, please follow the enclosed application instructions to apply the new labels to your child restraint.
