Dear Peterbilt Customer,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Peterbilt has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain vehicles manufactured with MX or MX-13 engines and a Leece Neville Alternator built between January 2011 and April 2015. The alternator charge cable on trucks equipped with a PACCAR MX or MX-13 engine and the Leece Neville Alternator may chafe against a formed metal Freon discharge line.

Alternator charge cable insulation chafing may result in increased risk of a fire.

<i>The problem is...</i>	Alternator charge cable chafing against metal freon discharge line
<i>Correction...</i>	Re-route the alternator charge cable away from the metal freon line.
<i>What you must do ...</i>	Contact your dealer immediately to schedule an appointment

Peterbilt has initiated a recall to remedy the defect free of charge. Please contact a Peterbilt dealership to schedule this repair. This repair should take approximately 1.0 hours labor, and will be performed at no charge to you. If you had this repair performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall.


